Wine Analysis

Winemaker: Greg Clack

In the Vineyard

Sourced from a number of vineyards consistently producing high quality wines from a combination of the southern and central Adelaide Hills. Both areas provide unique fruit spectrums to the resultant blend.

In the Winery

Portions of high quality fruit were fermented separately in stainless steel using minimal cap management to limit over extraction and maintain the varietal fruit characters. Fermentation was finished in stainless steel prior to maturation in oak in order to preserve as much primary fruit as possible. Post fermentation the wine was matured for 12 months in 100% French Oak.

In the Glass

Colour

Dark ruby red with a plum purple hue

Bouquet

Lifted aromas of blackcurrant, plum, chocolate and a hint of fruitcake. Lifted notes of mint, eucalypt and black olives.

Palate

An intensely flavoured varietal example with good expression of primary fruits – blackcurrant, dark plums and hints of mint. A touch of savoury oak integrates seamlessly with the primary fruit characters. Firm but velvety tannins and tight acid give good structure and balance.

Medium to full bodied, with a long persistent flavoursome finish. It will perfectly accompany a good hearty winter dish.
